

# Short speed magazine pouch -12

## Features

A single magazine pouch.  
The size is easily changed with the elastic cord.  
Low profile to make it easier to work in an open hatch or in a car.

The elastic string closure in the top is fast and easy to open. It is threaded through an eye let further down than normal, this makes it easier to fold the elastic string to the side when you want to remove the magazine fast.

Low cut to make it faster to remove the magazine.

Inside Velcro patches were small holders for pistol magazines or grenades can be attached

25 mm MOLLE bands on the outside so you can attach other pouches on the outside.

Two or more magazine pouches can be attached outside each other.

Eyelet in the bottom to let water out.  
Tuck in attachment system makes it possible to attach the pouch on any equipment vest or belt.

Stores: 1 x G36 or other 1 x 5,56 or 1 x HK417 magazine or radio, pistol etc.



The attachment systems is easy to use both on standard 25 mm MOLLE systems as well as on the Swedish 20 mm system or on 50 or 60 mm belts



The pull tab is designed to work with magazines with an angled bottom.



The pouch is suitable for magazines, radios and other equipment.



The elastic band can be adjusted with the cord lock on the front.

# Short speed magazine pouch -12



Universal flap, 25-00007-00-000 can be attached on the magazine pouch.  
The flap has a silent hook opening that is easy and fast to use.



The closed flap protects the content of the pouch and keeps dirt out.



The flap is attached in the top in the back attachment bands.



Dual holder insert -12, 25-00307-09-000 can be used to hold smaller magazines inside the short speed magazine pouch -12.  
The insert has 2 elastic holders with adjustable length bottom.



One SMG magazine and one pistol magazine in the speed magazine pouch -12.  
A baton or other similar objects can be carried in the pouch in this way.



The Dual holder insert is attached on the inside back of the pouch with Velcro



# Short speed magazine pouch -12

## MOLLE



Our pouches are compatible with both standard 25 mm MOLLE (Grey webbing on the picture) and 20 mm Swedish Molle (Olive webbing on the picture).



Place the pouch in the position you want it. Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the MOLLE band on the carrier.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch under the first 25 mm band on the back of the pouch.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the next MOLLE band on the carrier.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch under the next 25 mm band on the back of the pouch.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the next MOLLE band on the carrier.



When you have reached the bottom of the pouch, make sure to go UNDER the blue band. On this pouch, we also went under the grey band. **But you MUST ALWAYS go under the blue band.**



Fold the attachment band and go into the tunnel on the pouch



This is what it should look like when it is ready. Pull the pouch to make sure it is securely attached.

# Short speed magazine pouch -12

## Swedish "Molle"



Our pouches are compatible with both standard 25 mm MOLLE (Grey webbing on the picture) and 20 mm Swedish Molle (Olive webbing on the picture).



Place the pouch in the position you want it. Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the MOLLE band on the carrier.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch under the first 10 mm band (olive in this pouch) on the back of the pouch.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the next MOLLE band on the carrier. Then push the attachment bands on the pouch under the next 10 mm band on the back of the pouch.



Push the attachment bands on the pouch through the next MOLLE band on the carrier. Then push the attachment bands on the pouch under the next 10 mm band on the back of the pouch.



When you have reached the bottom of the pouch, make sure to go **UNDER** the blue band.

**You MUST ALWAYS go under the blue band.**



Fold the attachment band and go into the tunnel on the pouch



Both attachment bands are under the blue band and secured inside the tunnel.



This is what it should look like when it is ready. Pull the pouch to make sure it is securely attached.
